Formula/Food Sign-Off Statement

Dear Parent,

Matrix Head Start's participates in the Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP). The CACFP is a child nutrition program of the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA). Childcare centers are reimbursed a meal rate to help with the cost of serving nutritious meals to enrolled children. The meals must meet CACFP meal pattern requirements for children and infants.

To meet CACFP requirements, Matrix Head Start offers formula and other required infant food to all enrolled infants. The iron-fortified infant formula provided for infants until they turn one year of age is:

Ready-To-Use Enfamil Infant NeuroPro

If your child is in need of an infant formula other than the formula stated above or is in need of powder infant formula, then an Individualized Health Care Plan Form is required. When your infant turns one year of age, the center will begin to provide milk and the other required food items to meet the meal pattern requirements for toddler-age children.

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
